The Village of Morton Grove in collaboration with the Cook County Sheriff's Cell Phones for Seniors Program will be distributing free 911 cellular telephones to residents over the age of 65, who do not have a cellular phone. Having a cell phone that can reach emergency services offers seniors an extra measure of security as they are driving, taking public transportation or participating in outdoor events. The Village will be sponsoring a

distribution event on February 14, 2007.

The Village's Department of Family and Senior services is asking local businesses and Morton Grove residents to donate their old and unwanted cell phones to the Sheriff's Cell Phones for Seniors Program. Drop off boxes are located at the American Legion Memorial Civic Center at 6140 Dempster St. or the Morton Grove Village Hall at 6101 Capulina, during regular business hours.

The Sheriff's cell phone program will accept any brand, make or model of cellular telephone whether it is in working order or not. Even components of cellular telephones will be accepted

Federal/Illinois Mandatory posters

On December 18, 2006 Governor Blagojevich signed a \$1-an-hour minimum wage increase into law. Starting July 1, 2007, Illinois businesses will be required to pay most workers at least \$7.50 an hour. That will be followed by three 25-cent increases, as follows: to \$7.75 on July 1, 2008; to \$8.00 on July 1, 2009: and to \$8.25 on July 1, 2010.

Due to this significant revision, the Illinois Department of Labor's Notice to Employer and Employees will be revised. This is required to be posted by all Illinois employers with one or more employees, in a conspicuous place where every employee has daily access to it.
